# Eye Transplant (Corneal Transplantation) Cost Guide

## What is Corneal Transplantation?

A corneal transplant is a [procedure](#) to remove damaged cornea and replace it with healthy donor tissue. A corneal transplant is frequently known as keratoplasty or corneal graft. It can be used to recover sight, treat severe infection, correct the damage, and relieve pain. ## Why would a person need cornea transplantation?

Corneal transplants are typically done to correct eyesight problems that have occurred due to certain medical conditions. Some of the most common reasons for needing a cornea transplant include:

### Keratoconus

[Keratoconus](#) is a condition that makes the cornea thinner, weaken, and change shape. Approximately from 1 in 3,000 to 1 in 10,000 people are affected by this condition. The exact reason for the condition is not known. There may be a hereditary link, and it's more common in people with various allergic conditions, like asthma and eczema.

Keratoconus is one of the most common causes of corneal transplantation in younger patients. It doesn't commonly become visible until the early teens, however, can sometimes happen earlier. Most of the cases of keratoconus are mild and can be controlled by using glasses or contact lenses. However, in some patients, it can develop to the point where a cornea transplant is required.

### Degenerative conditions

Few conditions might affect the eyes and cause them to gradually develop problems over time. For example in Fuchs' endothelial dystrophy, the functioning of the cells lining the inner cornea which is called the endothelium starts to weaken. This occurs faster as you get older. As the cells deteriorate, instead of clearing excess fluid, they allow it to build up, leading to cloudy vision.

### Other reasons

A cornea transplant may also be performed if:

- A small hole appears in the cornea as a result of damage (called as a corneal tear)
- Cornea infection that does not respond to antibiotics and keeps coming back
- The cornea is damaged due to an infection or injury

## What is the Average Cost of Corneal Transplantation?

Corneal transplantation is one of the most effectively achieved tissue transplant techniques. Corneal transplant recipients usually need shorter hospital stays (in few cases, just 2 hours), lower hospital charges, and frequently require only topical immunosuppressive therapy.
